

Kawasaki Ninja ZX-6R bikes in Doha testing

THE Light Speed team are currently here in Doha, testing their Kawasaki Ninja ZX-6R bikes prior to the World Supersports and Superbikes championships on February 24.

This was announced at a press conference by Nasser Bin Khaled & Sons Services, the dealers of the Kawasaki Ninja ZX-6R.

Speaking at the press conference, NBKS Services General Manager Ahmed Saad al-Deen Habib said, "As we have constantly proved, NBKS is the market leader in introducing some of the world's best machines. This past couple of weeks we have also brought Qatar a world first by holding the first unveiling of the Ninja ZX-6R."

Chief Operations Officer of NBKS Services' Automotives division Paul J Maryan thanked the team at NBKS for the successful launch of the bike.

"We have seen an explosion in interest in the sport of motorcycling in Qatar over the past few years and we have witnessed a number of local riders taking up the sport," said Kawasaki (Qatar) manager Tarke Mohammed Sherif Al-Attar.

Light Speed Team Manager Davide Bulega was quite pleased that his team would be the first to test ride the new Ninja bike.

The Light Speed Team will be led 17-year old Davide Guigliano, the youngest rider in the championship. Davide was the winner of the 2005 Kawaski Italian Ninja Cup and finished third in the 2007 Europe Super Stock 600.
